- 4. The recipe must contain some kind of chocolate (dark, milk, chocolate chips, white chocolate, etc.).
- 5. The candy recipe can be of any type: molded, dipped, painted, filled, soft/fudge like, or hard/crunch.
- 6. Each entry needs to provide one complete batch/recipe placed on a disposable plate/container, with wax paper between layers (if needed), and in an appropriate sized zip lock type bag. After judging, the rest of the candy will be sold as part of the fundraising event.
- 7. Entries will be judged on taste, texture, appearance, and use of chocolate.
- Product must be delivered to the Adrian High School between 11:00 and 11:30 A.M. on February 6, 2010. Judging will start at 11:30 A.M. After 11:30 A.M. no registered contestants will be accepted
- 9. Contestants cannot be present during the judging. The decisions of the judges are final and may not be appealed.
- 10. Participants must complete a registration form and submit the entry fee by Thursday, Feb. 4th (see form below). Completing a signed registration form releases the copyright, guarantees that the recipe is his/her original work, and gives Adrian Schools Educational Foundation permission to feature his/her name, hometown, school, and recipe on site and in future publications to the public.
- 11. Winners will be announced and presented their awards during the CHOCOPALOOZA event after 1:00 P.M on February 6, 2010.
